

Santa Maria presso San Satiro

9th century church with frescoes. wooden sculptures, Bramante's trompe l'oeil painting

Museo Poldi-Pezzoli

A house-museum in former home of a 19th century art collector

Villa Necchi Campiglio

A 95 acres park with monuments, public art, ponds and landscaped gardens

Castello Sforzesco

Sforza Castle surrounded by walls and towers, preserves frescoes by Leonardo and Pietà Rondanini by Michelangelo
